## **CARE Feline TNR** Can Help!

- 1. Provide food and water every day
- 2. Provide shelter from cold and heat
- 3. TNR: Trap to get cat fixed population control
- 4. Return cats back to their original territory or find a friendly home for them

## **CARE Feline TNR** offers a program with low-cost or free options for you.

- CARE will loan you humane traps if needed for those feral/wild cats that can't be caught by hand.
  Traps are painless and won't harm.
- CARE will give you instructions on how to trap and care for the cat during this time.
- CARE will make an appointment for you at a partnered vet clinic.
- Cat receives spay/neuter, vaccines, pain meds & more
- A small part of the ear is clipped at the top. "Ear-tip", a universal symbol of a spayed/neutered feral cat.
- The cat is picked up by you and released back to where you trapped it AFTER recovery.

Please continue to feed and ALWAYS provide FRESH water.
